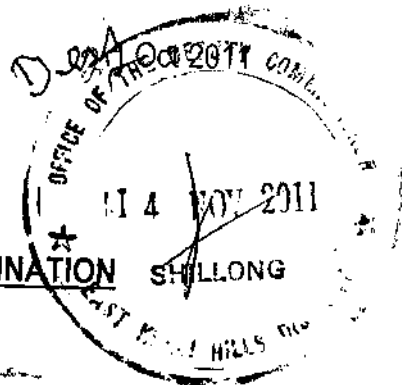

3. It is proposed to conduct the All India Sainik School Entrance Examination written exam in different centres in State of Assam besides centres at State of Meghalaya and Sikkim. A copy of the Entrance Examination Notification released to the Press is enclosed for your information and perusal.

4. It is requested that necessary instructions/Government Resolution may please be issued for constituting the Examination Boards as proposed under for conducting the written test on **Sunday the 08 Jan 2012**. Representatives from this School will be detailed to each centre to assist the board in the smooth conduct of the examination.

(a) A regular Defence Service Officer not below the rank of Lt Col detailed by Deputy Director General NCC Meghalaya as Officer In-charge.

(b) The District Education Officer or his representative who will act as supervisor for fair and smooth conduct of examination and administrative arrangements.

(c) Representative of the School.

5. District Education Officer or his representative so detailed is to act as supervisor and will be responsible for :-

(a) Making personal liaison with the Head of the Institution detailed as Centre Superintendent to ensure availability of School, Examination Hall/Class rooms, furniture, and drinking water at the place of examination on **08 Jan 2012**.

(b) Safe custody of the Question Papers which will be handed over by an Officer/Representative of this School.

- (c) Detailing invigilators who can read English/Assamese/Hindi). The number of invigilators would depend on the number of students appearing and the capacity of each examination hall/class room. Ratio should not exceed 1:30.
- (d) Ensuring seating arrangements for the candidates at their respective centres.
- (e) Arranging one Clerk, Peon, and Waterman each for the centre.
- (f) Assist the Centre Superintendent in smooth and fair conduct of examination.
6. It will be appreciated if the name, addresses, contact number of the persons detailed by you as per para 4 could be intimated to us at the earliest so that further arrangements for the conduct of the examination can be made in time.
7. The District Education Officer concerned may be directed that :-
- (a) District Education Officer is either be personally available during the conduct of the examination or detail his nominee not below the post of Deputy Education Officer as Member of Board.
- (b) The examination should be conducted on the same pattern in regard to seating arrangement and supervision etc as any Public School Examination.
8. Instructions may also be issued to the District Magistrate and all concerned officials of the Examination Centres to detail their nominee and ensure their presence at the respective centres well in time. Superintendent of Police of the concerned Districts may also be directed to monitor fair and smooth conduct of the examination and deploy adequate personnel on the day of the examination at every venue.
9. It is further requested that necessary Government Orders may please be issued to the District Education Officers of the centres concerned and Head of the institutions where the subject examination is going to be conducted well in advance.


